CALL FOR CENIT@EA MASTER AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The East African Community (EAC) Secretariat and GIZ are implementing the Centre of Excellence for ICT in East Africa (CENIT@EA) regional project. The objective of the project is to offer digital skills that meet the needs of the private sector and civil society stakeholders in the region to facilitate digital transformation.

This project is implemented within the framework of cooperation between the East African Community (EAC) and the German Government through the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation (BMZ). The project includes a market driven master's programme in "Embedded and Mobile Systems" (MSc EMoS) developed by a consortium of East African and German Universities. The MSc EMoS is offered at the Nelson Mandela African Institute for Science and Technology (NM- AIST) in Arusha, Tanzania. Currently sixty-four (64) students from East African Partner States are enrolled under full scholarships in the first and second cohort.

This is to call for applications for third cohort for the CENIT@EA. The course is expected to begin in January, 2021. The successful candidates will be offered full scholarships. Female candidates are encouraged to apply.
